
God is Supreme (from The Never-Ending, Ever-Growing List of the Character Traits of God)

The popular, and false, teaching of Prosperity Gospel preachers lead us to believe we can think, pray, or do the right thing, and God is then compelled to bless us.


Not so.

"That they may know that You alone, whose name is the LORD, Are the Most High over all the earth." (Psalm 83:18 NASB).







